IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

District 201 reviews residency on a yearly basis. Requirements for residency proofs are determined by year in school. Proving residency will be accomplished by providing the following information:

Residency Proofs:

- Current 11th graders – will not need to prove residency unless a residency concern was raised during 2013-2014 school year
- Current 9th and 10th graders – 5 proofs as described below.

One (1) document from Category A and four (4) documents from Category B.
